

Launch of Bersamamu

From 1 July 2019, Muslim couples who register for solemnization will receive more support in their journey towards a strong marriage. ROMM has launched *Bersamamu*, where solemnisers (Naib Kadi or Kadi) will befriend and support soon-to-wed Muslim couples as they prepare for marriage. The relationship will continue into the first 2 years of marriage, where couples can choose to meet regularly with their Naib Kadi or Kadi for practical advice and tips to build a strong marriage.

Choosing a solemniser

For solemnisations held at private venues, couples may choose a volunteer Kadi or Naib Kadi to be the solemnizer.

For solemnisations held at ROMM, either the Registrar or Deputy Registrar of ROMM, volunteer Kadi or a Naib Kadi can conduct the solemnisation.

Note:

- For weddings at Private Venues, couples may choose to give the Naib Kadi a token of appreciation for their efforts. This is entirely up to the couple.
- Couples should not provide tokens of appreciation to solemnizers for solemnizations held at ROMM.
- The Registrar and Deputy Registrars will conduct their solemnisations at ROMM.
